

UNCHARTED WINES

Dame Jeanne Cremant De Bourgogne Premices Rosé £30

This sparkling rosé has a deeper colour than you might first expect. 100% Pinot Noir from vines planted just outside the Champagne region means it offers amazing value for money. Organic farming and minimal intervention produce a bright, vivid wine with plenty of classic Pinot red berried fruit.

Menti Roncaie Sui Lievi Frizzante £17

Delicious unfiltered biodynamic frizzante. The juice selected is fermented by using only natural yeast in cement tanks, then there is a second fermentation in bottle with the addition of Albina juice (resin from the Garganega grape) with natural yeasts and natural sugars. It tastes sensational – fresh and youthful with dry cider notes. It's great on its own as an aperitif or with seafood and fish dishes

Les Deux Moulins Sauvignon Blanc £11

Vinified at very low temperatures in stainless steel, the focus of the winemaking is to add structure and body in the palate and to not over characterise the nose.

Marilina Sketta Grecanico IGP £15

A full on 'Skin Contact' biodynamic wine making creating a truly approachable Grecanico from Sicily. It simply glides down! A great all rounder but do try it with spicy dishes and hearty fish stews.

Westwell Ortega Rosé £17

This is a co-ferment (all the grapes in together) of Ortega and Regent, creating a coherent and complex wine. This delicious rose from Kent has a nose of wild raspberries and honeysuckle with flavours of cranberry, melon and twist of white pepper on the finish..

La Maldición Tinto de Valdilecha £11

A bright, bold comforting glass of red from Madrid. It's carefully made so the higher alcohol is fully integrated and the refreshing acidity means this wine won't overpower the food it is served with.

Choose to drink it with cheese and meat plates.

Domaine Saint-cyr La Galoche Beaujolais £17

This is a surprising dark colour for a Beaujolais and the flavour delivers a real depth too. The magic is that you get a full bodied Red which is elegant and fresh with light tannins so it can accompany pretty much any food – you can even enjoy it slightly chilled.

Hermit Ram Whole Bunch Pinot Noir - £25.50

Theo Coles sources his Pinot Noir from tiny vineyards, planted on limestone, in New Zealand's Canterbury Wine region. These are handcrafted, small volume wines that are naturally made without additions and without fining or filtration. A pure, vibrant expression of Pinot Noir with dark cherry fruit and floral aromatics from the use of whole bunches.
